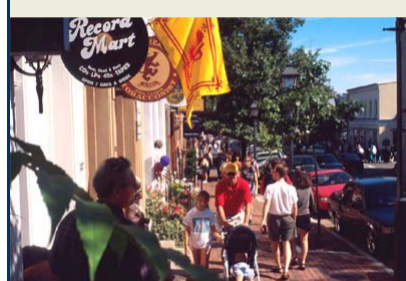

For 20 exhilarating minutes you will be in the water, experiencing first hand what it's like to be so close to these incredible animals. An informative and educational pre-encounter session will prepare you for your hands-on, shallow water program. All participants will be photographed during their interaction by our professional staff photographers. To participate in Discover Dolphins, you must be at least 5 years of age. Participants 7 years of age or under must be accompanied by a paying participating adult 13 years and up.
