Wander from Savannah, GA to Georgetown, SC

One of the most historically significant and beautiful scenic drives you can take in the Southeast is from Savannah to Georgetown. Take one or two weeks and enjoy this incredibly gorgeous region. Located four hours southeast of Atlanta, but a world away from that bustling, modern metropolis, Savannah offers an enchanting stroll back in time. Savannah is widely renowned for its historical features which stand as an open invitation for visitors to uncover its hidden charms. Luscious peach trees, Civil War history, delicious cuisine, and ethnic festivals are part of the Savannah experience.

A center of luxury homes prior to the Civil War, Beaufort was one of a few southern cities spared from fire in the war's aftermath, making it an architectural treasure. The oldest house (at Port Republic and New Streets) was built in 1717, before the birth of George Washington. Beaufort is one of the few towns in the United States whose entire downtown has been designated by the National Trust for Historic Preservation as an historic district. Nearly 200 restored buildings can be seen in the city's historic district. More than 50 historic buildings have been identified and include lovely private homes beautifully restored.

Elegant and refined, Charleston mixes European charm with new world energy and excitement. From 26 miles of white sand beaches to non-stop casino action, sophisticated shopping, culture, history, arts, delectable cuisine and championship golf courses, the Playground of the South has it all. Outdoor fun continues year round in Biloxi's mild climate. Get a bird's-eye view of the entire shoreline with a parasail ride over the Gulf or hop on a jet ski, try your hand at windsurfing, sailing, skiing or motor boating. Water parks with everything from a wave pool, slides, bumper boats, and amusements such as miniature golf, rides and arcades are also among the list of favorite places on the Coast.



The ferry will transport visitors to a nearby barrier island for the ultimate beach experience. Daily shuttles make it easy for beach goers to explore Ship Island, a natural barrier island whose clear waters and constant surf make it a favorite stop on the Coast. The Coast is also home to Stennis Space Center, one of NASA's leading facilities for technology development.

Much of Biloxi's entertainment scene is swept up in the high-spirited fun of casino gaming. Twelve casinos have brought the excitement and glamour of Las Vegas to the beach, with table games, slot machines, and nightclub venues. All casinos are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Many of the casinos offer supervised activities for children; many are complete resort complexes with golf courses and luxury hotels.
